

POTENTIAL PROBLEM OF THE DISTRICT

- Improper selection of suitable paddy varieties according to land type and topography.
- Indiscriminate use of chemical fertilizer in Cereals
- High weed infestation in Kharif upland paddy
- High cost of cultivation due to lack of farm mechanization in cotton
- Post harvest losses in paddy due to mismanagement.
- Bacterial and fungal wilt in solanaceous vegetables
- Distress sale of onion due to poor storage structure.
- Weed infestation in Onion crops lowers the yield
- Less no. of female flower and fruit drop in Cucurbitaceous crops.
- Alternate bearing habit of local mango cultivar in the district.
- Availability of quality seeds of Pulses and Oilseeds (Less than 10 years old)
- Line sowing and plant population is not properly maintained in case of pulses & oilseeds
- Lack of awareness about use of herbicide, micronutrient application and seed inoculation in oilseed & pulses
- Unavailability of Cold tolerant Greengram variety
